Review: previous songs

Memory verse: Matthew 21:9- “And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, ‘Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!’” (ESV)

Read: Matthew 21:1-11

Sing: Jesus Goes to Jerusalem

True or false:

1. Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a horse?
2. Jesus sent two apostles ahead of him to retrieve the animal for him to ride on?
3. The whole city was stirred up when Jesus entered the city?

Questions:

1. What did people lay out on the ground in front of Jesus?
2. What did people shout as Jesus entered Jerusalem?
3. What prophecy was fulfilled in this scripture?

Craft: You will need: Print offs

tape or glue
pop cycle sticks
Construction paper
Fake fern

First print off images and have the children color them. Cut out Jesus image and then cut out line on the picture. Glue or tape a pop cycle stick to Jesus. Cut out cloaks from construction paper and glue on the road (not covering the cut out line). Also, glue pieces of fake fern along the road. Have the children slide the pop cycle stick through the cut out. Now Jesus can ride to Jerusalem.
