**Review:** previous songs

Memory verse: Mark 14:25- "Truly, I say to you, I will not drink again of the fruit

Read: John 13:1;3-17 and Mark 14:22-25

Sing: Jesus washed the apostles feet

**Vocabulary**: <u>Servant</u>-someone who does different jobs for another, such as a person employed in a home doing house hold duties.

<u>Passover</u>-The celebration each year remembering the Jews being freed from Egyptian slavery.

**Washing of feet-** in the time of Jesus people wore sandals. They traveled the streets and their feet became filthy. In a wealthy person's home a servant would come and wash a guest feet.
