Questions:


- 1. What did John the Baptist eat?

Craft: Your will need: large paper bags

A thick black ribbon or black construction paper Brown and tan markers or crayons Scissors and possibly tape

Cut the bag up the middle on one side. At the bottom of the bag cut out a circle that would fit a child's neck. Cut out arm holes on each side of the bag. Have the children color "camels hair" on the bag. Then cut the ribbon long enough to tie around the child's waist or cut out construction paper and tape around child's waste like a belt. Now the kids can dress up like John the Baptist in their camel hair vest and leather belt.
