Review: previous songs

Memory verse: John 4:7-“A woman from Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, ‘Give me a drink.’”(ESV)

Read: John 4:4-42 (for younger children read John 4:4-15;19-26;28-30;39-42)

Sing: The Samaritan Woman

Vocabulary: Samaritan- descendants from the Israelites that believe they are supposed to worship God on Mount Gerizim instead of Jerusalem.

True or false:

1. Jews loved Samaritans?
2. The Samaritan woman did not tell anyone about Jesus?
3. Jesus sat beside a well?
4. The Samaritan woman said “he told me all that I ever did.”

Questions:

1. What did Jesus ask of the Samaritan woman?
2. What did Jesus say he could give her?
3. Did the people of Samaria believe Jesus’s word?
4. Did the Samaritan woman find it odd when Jesus asked her for water?

Craft: Make a well

You will need: A paper or plastic cup

Brick pattern print off

Scripture printer

Scissors

Glue or tape

Print off brick pattern. Cut it the size of the outside of the cup. Glue stone print off around the outside of the cup. Cut out scripture and glue it to the inside of the bottom of the cup. Cut out pitcher.
